University Library was established in the year 2007. In the year August 2018, the Library was moved to a new building at the western side of the library block with a total carpet area of 6772 sq.ft. The University Library was established with spacious Reading Hall, E-Library, Circulation Section, Technical Processing Section, Reprographic Section, Librarian Cabin, Periodicals, Stacks, and Thesis sections. The University Library holds a vital position at Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University, supporting teaching, research, and extension activities. The University Library functions as a dynamic information center on campus, having elevated its standards by providing both traditional and online resources in an excellent, user-friendly environment for readers and research scholars.

## **Mission**

The mission of the University Central Library is to facilitate the creation of new knowledge through the acquisition, organization, and dissemination of knowledge resources, as well as to provide value-added services to university clients.

**To achieve this vision and mission, the university library organized, managed, and delivered services throughout the academic year 2024–2025. The report of the University Library annual academic work has been compiled and presented to the university.**

## **1. Procurements**

### **1.1 Procurement of E-Book**

E-Library of this university was established at the cost of Rs.2.51 crore funded by the Government of Tamil Nadu under the TANII scheme. The university library webpage provides electronic access to various full-text, bibliographical databases and e-journals to everyone seeking digital information. During the academic year 2024-2025 80 e-books were purchased using the third installment fund.

### 3.5 Reprographic Services

Reprographic services are provided at the University Library. A total of 799 copies were produced and issued to students and staff. An amount of Rs. 1,044/- was collected from members and non-members as reprographic charges. This amount has been deposited into the University account, and all challan have been submitted to the Registrar of TNPESU. Statements of accounts for the past twelve months have been submitted to the office. Additionally, 3,868 copies were reproduced for official purposes. In total, 4,667 copies were reproduced and issued to students, staff, and for library official use.

## **7.2 Maintenance of University Library**

Under the supervision of the Office Assistant, the library was

thoroughly cleaned. The cleaning staff swept the floors daily and mopped them once a week. Monthly, the tables, chairs, and computers were cleaned. ### 7.3 Revenue Generated

### 7.4 Implementation of Overdue Fine for Books

### **7.6 Advance Received and Settled**

The first advance amount of Rs. 12,800/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred Only) was received in four installments during the academic year 2024-2025 for the settlement of newspaper bills. A total of Rs. 11,107/- was spent on bill payments, and the unspent balance of Rs. 1,693/- was remitted to the university account on various dates.

The second advance amount of Rs. 25,000 was provided for the 14th convocation press meet held at Tamil Nadu Open University. A

total of Rs. 13,460 was spent on conducting the press meet, and the unspent balance of Rs. 11,540 was remitted to the University account on October 24, 2024.

The third advance has not yet been claimed or received from the University. The Librarians' Day and Best Library User Award ceremony were held on 12th August 2024. Approximately 60 staff members, students, and scholars participated in the event. For this purpose, Rs. 5,719 was spent on printing banners, invitations, and certificates; gift items; snacks; garlands; and travel allowances (TA) and daily allowances (DA) provided to the experts.

The fourth advance of Rs. 41,940 was received in June 2025 for the purchase of stationery items. Of this amount, Rs. 21,353 was spent on library-related stationery. The necessary stock entries have been recorded in the stock register, and the bills were certified and approved for payment. The consolidated bills were submitted to the university in September 2024. An excess amount of Rs. 1,353 was reimbursed.

Therefore, the four advance payments mentioned above were received and settled by the Deputy Librarian.

### 7.8 Stock Verification

#### **8.4 One Nation One Subscription (ONOS):**

The Department of Higher Education, Government of India, introduced the One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) scheme, effective January 2025. The Deputy Librarian took the initiative to enroll TNPESU as a member of the ONOS scheme and obtained access links to e-journals. This scheme, implemented by INFLIBNET, is available to all universities in India. Accordingly, we have received the access links from the INFLIBNET Centre, Gujarat. The scheme provides access to e-journals published by 30 international journal publishers. INFLIBNET supplies the access links to the publishers' websites. University research scholars, students, and staff can utilize these e-journals for their academic research and extension activities. The University Library has taken the initiative to include access links for all 30 publishers on the University Library website.

## 8.5 Amendment to the MOU for Shodhganga:

The INFLIBNET Centre sent an email dated 16 December 2024 to this university library regarding a new amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). The amendment requires universities to upload a one-page Ph.D. plagiarism summary report along with the scholar's ORCID ID, among other details. The amended MoU was mutually signed by the university and the INFLIBNET Centre, Gujarat. This activity was completed on 17 December 2024.

### 9.1 Library Advisory Committee Meeting

Dr. N. Ashok Kumar, Deputy Librarian, attended the Library Advisory Committee meeting held on March 7, 2025, at the Bihar Sports University campus in Rajgir.
