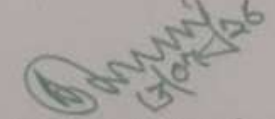

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About Us

University Library was established in 2007. In August 2018, the Library was relocated to a new building on the western side of the library block, encompassing a total carpet area of 6772 sq.ft. The University Library features a spacious reading hall, e-library, circulation section, technical processing section, reprographic section, librarian's cabin, periodicals section, stacks, and thesis section. It holds a vital position at Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University, supporting teaching, research, and extension activities. The University Library functions as a dynamic information center on campus, enhancing its standards by providing both traditional and online resources in an excellent, user-friendly environment for readers and research scholars.

Vision

“To provide quality published literature and timely library services.”

Mission

The mission of the University Central Library is to facilitate the creation of new knowledge through the acquisition, organization, and dissemination of knowledge resources, as well as to provide value-added services to university clients.

To achieve this vision and mission, the university library organized, managed, and delivered services throughout the academic year 2025–2026. The report of the University Library annual academic work has been compiled and presented to the university.

1. Procurements

1.1 Budget

The University requested a budget for the 2026-2027 academic year; therefore, the University Library submitted a budget proposal to the University on 19-12-2025. For consideration and approval.

1.2 Theses Addition

During the 2025–2026 academic year, a total of 100 Ph.D. theses were submitted to the Controller of Examinations and subsequently added to the university repository for public access and preservation. Barcode numbers were generated for each thesis and affixed to its spine. All submitted theses were assigned accession numbers ranging from 3663 to 3762 and shelved in the theses section for future reference.

2. Maintenance of Books, Journals & Reports

2.1 Shelf Order Maintenance

The task of rearranging the shelf bays and reshelving the books was completed between January and February 2026.

Shelf rectification and the detailed arrangement of books according to the Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) system were carried out from January to February 2026. All misplaced books were identified and returned to their correct shelves.

At the same time, it was observed that some books had damaged labels, while others lacked labels entirely. These books were identified, and new label stickers displaying the call numbers were prepared and affixed to ensure proper identification and organization on the shelves.

2.4 Newspapers Received

3. Delivery of Services

3.1 Library Membership

The University Library enrolls students and scholars as members each year, granting them access to library resources through a membership card valid until the completion of their course of study. A total of 274 students and scholars have submitted the membership application forms to the University Library and were enrolled as members during the 2025–2026 academic year.

3.3 Membership Card Lost

Members of University Library TNPESU have reported the loss of their ID/membership card, resulting in fines being collected. Between July 2025 and August 2025, 20 members paid a total fine of Rs. 1,200 (Rupees One Thousand two hundred only) through Indian bank challans. From September 2025 onwards, fines were collected through UPI payment. A total of 40 members paid the fine via UPI mode, amount to Rs.2350. During the academic year, a total of 60 members have reported their ID/membership cards as lost and paid fines amounting to Rs. 3550/-(Rupees three thousand five hundred and fifty only) to the university account.

3.6 Reprographic Services

Reprographic services are provided at the University Library. A total of 5,494 copies were produced and issued to students and staff. An amount of Rs. 6,262 was collected from members and non-members as reprographic charges, both in cash and via UPI payment. The cash collected from July 2025 to September 2025 has been deposited into the University account, and all challans have been submitted to the Registrar of TNPESU. From October 2025 onwards, reprographic service charges have been collected exclusively through UPI payments. Statements of accounts for the past twelve months have been submitted to the office. Additionally, 8,454 copies were reproduced for official purposes. In total, 13,948 copies were reproduced and issued to students, staff, and for official library use.

7.2 Maintenance of University Library

Under the supervision of the Library Office Assistant, the library was periodically cleaned throughout the academic year. The cleaning staff swept the floors daily and mopped them weekly. Library reading tables, chairs, and computers were cleaned every month. Additionally, the racks in the theses and stack sections were cleaned once a month.

7.3 Revenue Generated

The university library generates revenue through the collection of various service charges, including monthly photocopier charges, membership card fees, and overdue fines. A total of Rs. 36,013 was collected as revenue during the academic year 2025–2026 from both the members and non-

members. These funds were deposited into the university receipt account between July 2025 & August 2025 through Challan and from September onwards, UPI mode of payments was introduced, hence, students started paying the charges directly into the university account. The details are provided below.

7.4 Overdue Fine for Books

The collection of overdue fines from students returning library books past the due date, at a rate of Rs. 1 per day per book, was implemented in September 2024. During the academic year 2025–2026, overdue fines were collected in cash from July 2025 to September 14, 2025, amounting to Rs. 8,478. Following the instructions of the Registrar of TNPESU, a QR code-based online payment system was introduced on September 15, 2025, to collect overdue fines from students. Through this online payment system, a total of Rs. 17,023 was collected in the academic year 2025–2026. The entire amount collected through both methods was deposited into the university account, and all payment challans were submitted to the Registrar of TNPESU.

7.5 Bills Passed

7.6 Advance Received and Settled

A total of Rs. 12,800/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred Only) was received in four installments as an advance during the academic year 2025-2026 to cover newspaper bill payments. Of this amount, Rs. 11,289/- was utilized for bill payments over 12 months. The remaining balance of Rs. 1,511 was remitted to the university account in four separate installments. To this effect, four letters requesting the issuance of advance amount letters were submitted to the Registrar's office, and four settlement letters along with the remittance challans for the unspent balance were also submitted on separate occasions.

The second advance was received for organizing the Librarian's Day cum Best Library User Award ceremony. A sum of Rs.15000/- was sanctioned for this purpose. The Librarians' Day and Best Library User Award ceremonies were held on August 12, 2024. A total of 62 staff members, students, and scholars participated in this event. For this purpose, Rs. 7,693 was spent for printing banners, invitations, and certificates; gift items; snacks; rose garlands; and travel and daily allowances (TA and DA) provided to the experts. The unspent balance amount of Rs.7307/- has been remitted into the university account at Indian Bank. The advance claim settlement request letter, along with a programme report, was submitted to the office of the Registrar on 4th November 2025.

The third advance of Rs. 10,000 was received in March 2026 for replacing broken floor tiles. A total expenditure of Rs. 11,923 was incurred for the tile replacement. The bills were certified and passed for payments. Consolidated bills were submitted to the Registrar on 16th March 2026. An excess of Rs. 1,923 was reimbursed by the University to the Deputy Librarian. And the account was settled.

Therefore, the three advance accounts claimed were utilized for the specific purpose and the accounts were settled by the Deputy Librarian.

7.8 Stock Verification

The stock verification of Library books was conducted from 22nd May, 2026, to June 09, 2026. According to the university library accession register, out of 7,964 books, 7,755 were physically available, 79 were under circulation, 11 were lost by students/staff with fines collected, and 1 (one) book was transferred from the university library to the registrar section.

A total of 118 books were found to be missing through the 2CQR RFID Stock Verification Device. Among these, only two 2 books were missing from the academic year 2025–2026, while 116 books were missing from previous academic years' stock verification.

Before the commencement of stock verification, a technical issue was observed in the 2CQR RFID Stock Verification System, whereby the scanned book count was incorrectly displayed as doubled or multiplied, and some unscanned books were also reflected in the system. The issue was reported to the 2CQR support team and resolved with their assistance. The stock verification process was then carried out and completed successfully. A summary of stock verification is provided below.

7.9 SSL Certificate for University Library Webpage

The University Library website SSL Certificate expires in september 2025, and requires renewal. Thus, we have approached M/s. MOSYS, Bangalore, the service provider for submission of proforma invoice for renewal of SSL certificate for a further two-year period. Hence, the proforma invoice dated 21.08.2025 has been sent by the service provider. The proforma invoice for renewal of SSL certificate was submitted to the university requesting them to pay Rs.6490/-. The University paid the proforma invoice amount on 30.10.2025. M/s. MOSYS, Bangalore, has submitted an Invoice No. MOSYS/25-26/0132 dated 15.10.2025 for our payment valid for two years.

However, during this period, the University Library website was completely offline due to the unavailability of internet connectivity. After the internet connection and library web server services were restored in March 2026. We have informed the service provider, M/s. MOSYS to renew the SSL certificate. Based on this, they have renewed the SSL certificate; meanwhile, due to change in the government regulations, SSL certificates must be renewed every 8 eight months only. Hence the service provider assured of renewing the certificate thrice for two years period. They have renewed university library website ssl certificate for a period of 8 months from 26 March 2026 to 11 October 2026 which will be the first time renewal. The remaining two renewals will fall duly on 12 October 2026 to 11 June 2027 second time and 12 June 2027 to 11 February 2028 third time.

7.10 University Library Working on Saturday's

The proposal to keep the university library open on Saturdays to promote reading habits on campus has been submitted to the Vice Chancellor. The University Library has been operating on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m, since 1st February 2020. During the academic year a total of **288** students and scholars visited the library and utilized its services and facilities on Saturdays. The details are as follows.

7.12 Library Floor Tiles Damage

In the reading hall of the University Library, we observed that there were approximately 30 to 35 floor tiles broken in November 2025 due to air cracks. The situation to replace the broken floor tiles was noticed to the Registrar Office via letter on 17-11-2025. We have requested them to sanction a sum of Rs.10,000/- to replace the tiles in order to avoid injury and further damage to the floor. The university has sanctioned a sum of Rs.10000/- budget for the replacement of the broken tiles in the University Library. The task was completed during the academic year.

7.13 Pending Payment Released

The University has to pay a sum of Rs. 16 lakhs to M/s. Allied Publishers for the supply of e-books to the university library. We have passed the invoice for payment, letter dated 26-02-2025. The agency has sent three reminder emails to the registrar's section and finally approached the university library in person, informing us that they have not received the payment. From the university library, we have reminded the registrar's office through a letter dated 25-07-2025 to release the payment.

However, there has been no reply from them, and we have started tracing the status of the file. Unfortunately, the payment note file, along with the invoice, has been misplaced in the office. We have approached the VC CC member to sort out the issue. She assured us that she would trace the file in the secretariat, but the file was not located.

Finally, the purchase handling staff found the file in the registrar section. We then requested M/s. Allied Publishers subscription agency to submit a fresh invoice for payment. They submitted invoice no. CHNJ/EBKS/11001, dated 27-01-2025, which was then passed for payment and submitted to the section for the release of payment. The invoice amount of Rs. 16,00,794/- was paid to the agency on 30-10-2025, and the claim was settled.

7.14 UPS Batteries Replaced

The University Library UPS power backup failed in the month of November 2025. We have invited a service engineer to attend the call. After examining the machine and battery he suggested replacing 20 units of 20KVA batteries to fix the power backup issue. Based on the suggestion we have submitted a request letter to the registrar to purchase batteries for university library. The registrar office placed purchase order with M/s. Power Platform, for the supply of batteries under buyback of old batteries scheme to the university library. Hence, 20 units of 20KVA UPS batteries were replaced on 13-01-2026, and an invoice No.11, amounting of Rs.1,99,240/- was submitted to university library, which was passed for payment. The old batteries 20 units returned to M/s. Power Platform to compensate buy back scheme. The finance section paid the invoice amount to the supplier. The task of replacing of batteries work was completed during the academic year. and the power backup was restored in university

7.15 UPS Machine Service

While installation UPS batteries, the technicians found that, one of the UPS machine available in the University Library was out of order, and they suggested servicing the machine for power backup. We requested the Registrar of TNPESU through a letter dated 23-01-2026 seeking permission to lend the machine for servicing work with M/s. Power Platform, Chennai. The university officers granted permission to lend the machine for service, based on this we have invited the service provider and handed over the machine for service on 16-02-2026. The UPS machine was serviced and returned to the University Library and installation work was carried out on **07.04.2026**. Subsequently, **Invoice No. 22, dated 09.05.2026**, amounting to Rs.29,948 was submitted by the service provider. The invoice was certified and passed for payment by the Deputy Librarian on 13-05-2026 and forwarded to the University for payment processing.

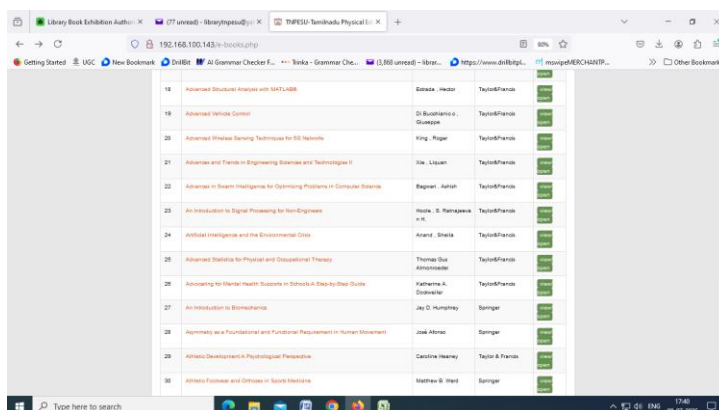
7.16 E-Books Updated on University Library Website

8.3 QR Code Based Online Payment

We have requested the university authorities to implement a QR Code based online payment system in the University Library from 2025-2026 onwards. A proposal letter dated 03-07-2025 was submitted to The Registrar, TNPESU to provide with a university account linked QR code device with sound box.

The University has accepted our request and instructed the Indian Bank Branch Manager to provide a QR Code device with sound box. The manager informed me that a payment of Rs. 2360/- is required to obtain the device. The finance section disbursed the amount to the Indian bank manager on 21-08-2025. The manager then provided us with an application form we have filled out the form and submitted it to the manager on 25-08-2025. The device was supplied and installed in the university library on 12-09-2025. The implementation of the QR code based online payment scheme was communicated to the students of TNPESU through a circular on 12-09-2025. The scheme started successfully from 15-09-2025. We have intervened in the process made fruitful correspondence between university and the bank manager. Finally we have succeeded in getting the device and implemented the system.

This new system enables students to effortlessly pay their book fines, photocopying fees, and charges for lost or duplicate membership cards via online payment by scanning the QR code. This initiative helps to save time, reduce cash handling, and promote a smoother and faster payment process within the library.

Because of this initiative, a total of 442 students have paid their charges and fines by using the system and they feel happy and thankful for implementing it in the university library. A sum of Rs.23,095/- amount has been collected using the device for the academic year 2025-2026.

The Deputy Librarian has requested the University on 30.01.2025 to include a menu ONOS in University Library Website. The University authorities accepted the request and an email sent to website developer OGSS on 30.01.2025. However due to lack of firewall in the campus the internet connectivity was disconnected to the web server and the University Library website access stopped. The firewall was not purchased by the university still march 2026. Meanwhile the deputy librarian enquired with the NIC team to restore internet connectivity to library web server without firewall. Based on the request they have configured the DNS and restored the public IP access to the web server on 26.03.2026. The technical support provided by NIC restored the university library website access.

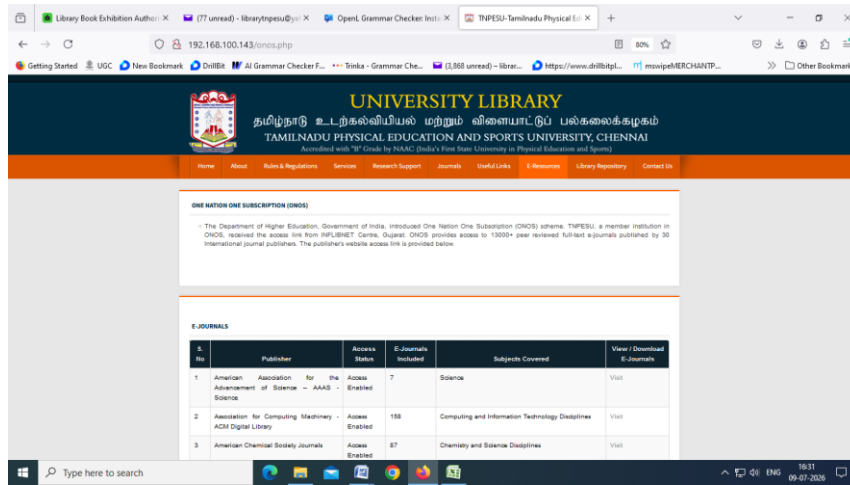
Therefore, we have requested the university on 28-04-2026 to give administrative approval for to include a menu ONOS on University Library website. The university has given permission to include the menu which was intimated to M/s. OGSS. The OGSS team requested few files pertaining to e-resources for design the menu we have sent the same through email. They visit the university library on 8th May 2026 and accessed the library server physically to design the menu ONOS. They have successfully designed the menu and included ONOS menu and the 30 publisher's website links in the menu. The task provides e-journal access to our students, scholars and faculty they can access e-journals published by 30 international journal publishers. The publisher's website access link and screenshot of ONOS menu is provided below. We have tested the menu which working properly. The new ONOS menu update in the university library website was intimated to the faculty through a circular on 18-05-2026, which was communicated through official whatsapp group.

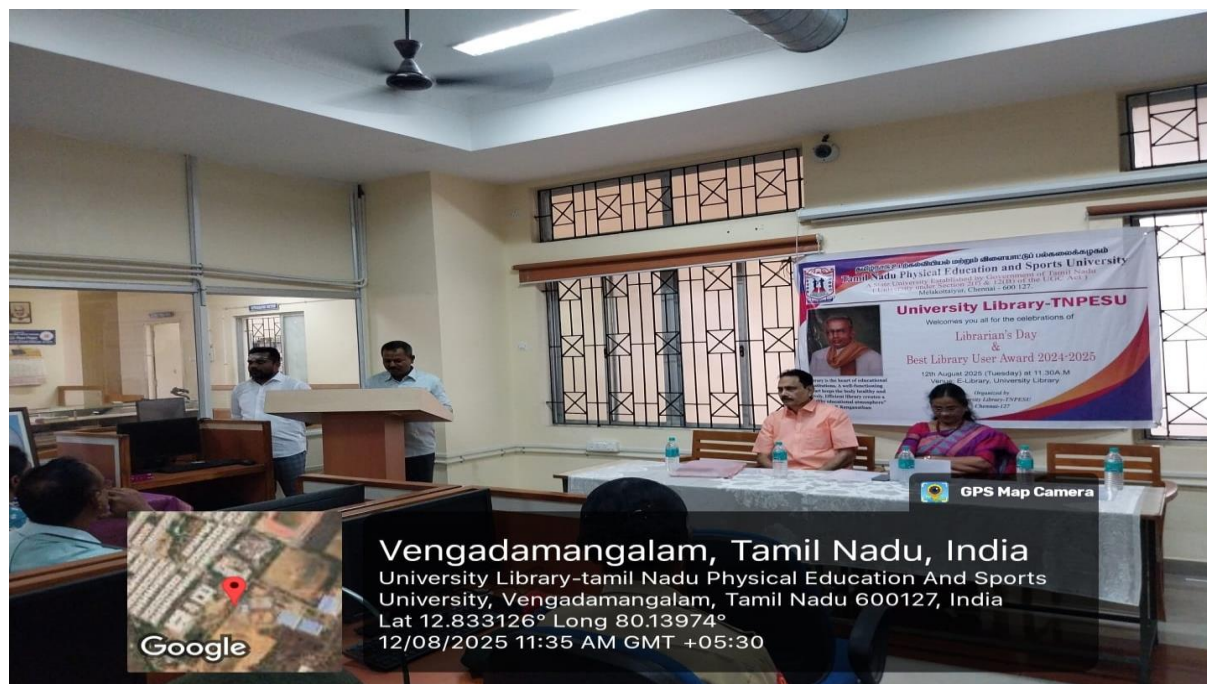

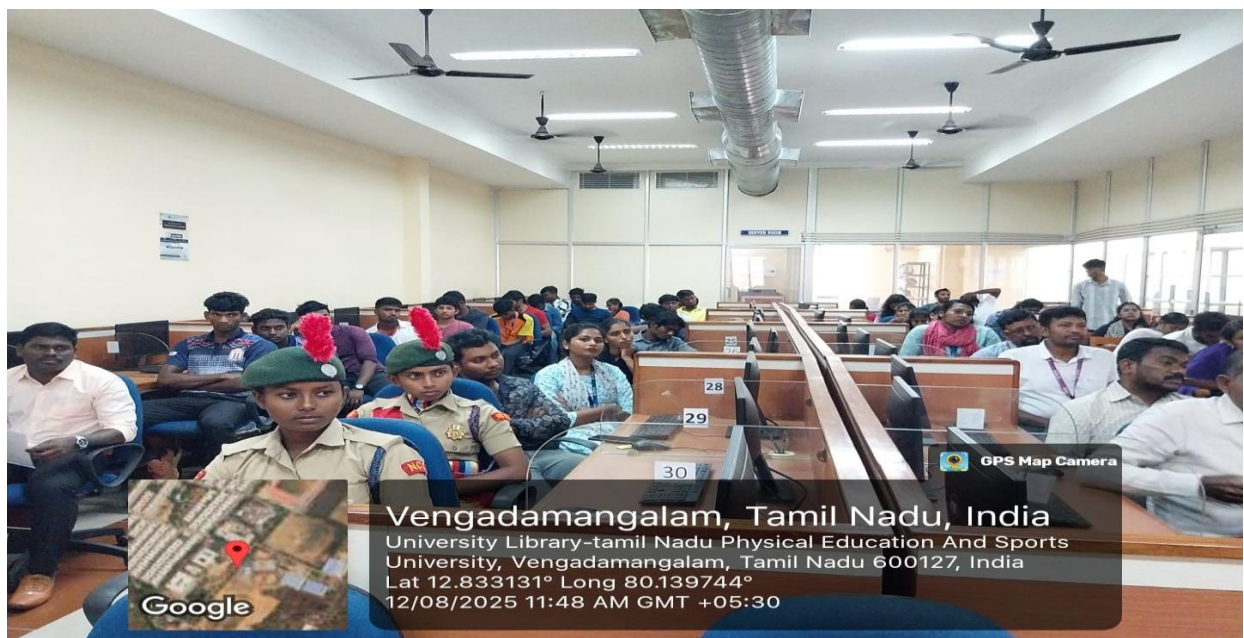
